THE COURSE INCORPORATES AN INTERDISCIPLINARY APPROACH AND IS DESIGNED FOR PROPERTY AND EVIDENCE TECHNICIANS, PROPERTY AND EVIDENCE SUPERVISORS, AND ANYONE INVOLVED OR INTERESTED IN THE HANDLING AND **NATIONAL BEST PRACTICES** IN PROPERTY AND EVIDENCE. IN UNISON WITH THE STUDENT'S INTERNAL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES, THIS COURSE WILL ASSIST THE PROPERTY ROOM TEAM WITH THE KNOWLEDGE AND CONFIDENCE NEEDED TO PROPERLY COLLECT, PACKAGE, INTAKE, STORE, REMOVE, PURGE, AND TEST **HIGH PRIORITY ITEMS** IN THE PROPERTY ROOM.
